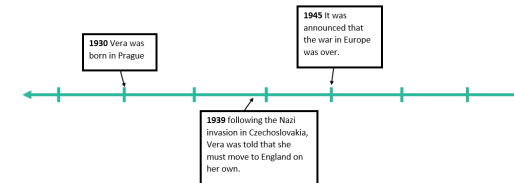
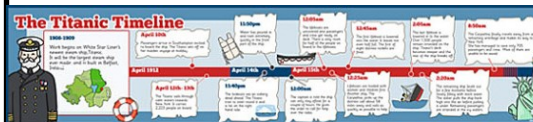
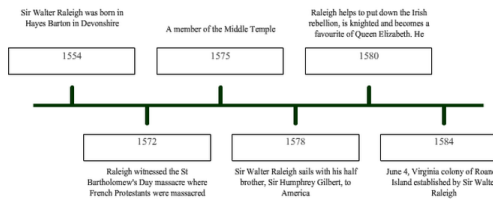
Journey	A long trip from one place to another.

Indigenous	Having origin in a country or locality ; native.

Prejudice	Hatred or unfair treatment toward a person or group without cause or reason.

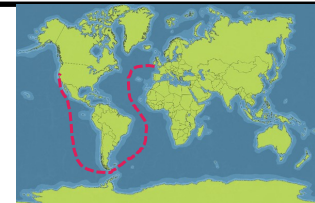
Sir Walter Raleigh was an English explorer, soldier and writer.

There were 1,324 passengers and 884 crew on board the Titanic.

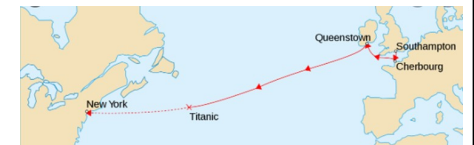
Over 10,000 children were evacuated during WW2.
