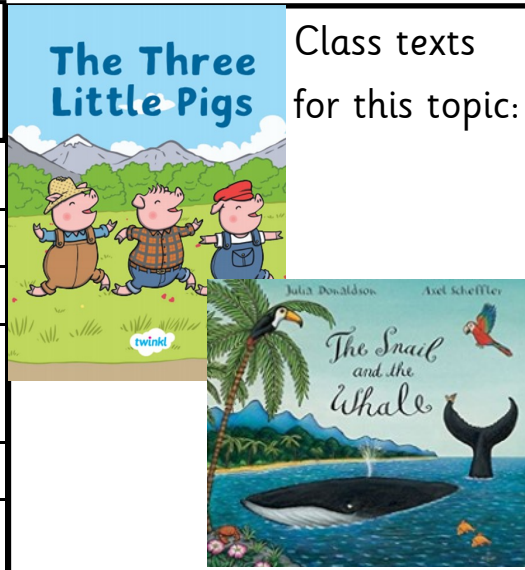


# People and their Communities

### Vocabulary

world	the earth and all those who live on it
country	land or area of land
United Kingdom	a nation in north-western Europe on the islands of Great Britain and Ireland and made up of England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland
landmark	a historic building or thing
rainforest	a dense evergreen forest, mostly found in tropical areas, that receives a large amount of rain all year long
mosque	a Muslim place of worship
climate	the usual weather conditions in a place
equator	the imaginary circle around the earth that is halfway between the North and South Poles
harbour	a sheltered area of water where boats can be anchored
coast	the land next to the ocean; seashore
continent	one of the earth's seven major areas of land. The continents are Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America, and South America
city	a large and important town where many people live and work
capital	the city where the government of a country, state, or province is located
community	a particular area where a group of people live
