Our class text for this half term is 'Who let the Gods out?' by Maz Evans. We will be writing in a range of different styles, including narrative (retelling) and information text.

Maths

This half term we will be focusing on algebra, measurement and ratio. During algebra, we will be learning how to form expressions, before moving on to solving more complex equations involving up to 2 unknown values. Following this, our measurement unit will be made up of converting units, perimeter, area and volume. Finally, we will explore ratio, where we will understand the relationship between two values.
